

Once again, the Fundació Vila Casas is holding its competition to award a prize, on a rotating basis, in the disciplines of painting, sculpture and photography. This year, the award is the **Sculpture Antoni Vila Casas Prize 2024** and the judges, formed by Caterina Almirall, Pilar Bonet, Natàlia Chocarro, Bernat Puigdollers, Stella Rahola and Joan Torras and has selected **28 finalist works** from among all **320 proposals** that have been submitted in this edition.

On April 27th, during the opening of the exhibition, the winners of this edition were announced. **Marc Larré** was the winner of the first prize, awarded with 15000 € and an exhibition next year at Can Framis Museum, with the work *2 braços, 3 genolls, 5 mans i 12 peus*. The jury also awarded a second prize to **Ariadna Parreu** for the work *Viró*. Both works have become part of the art collection of the Fundació Vila Casas.
